When produced, I would like to air the series on our two northwest public television stations, KWSU in the Spokane market and KTNW in the Yakima market." He also wrote, "I see a series like this to be an excellent complement to Ken Burns' national park series that will come to public television this fall. While I understand [Pedal America] may not be ready by fall, the Ken Burns series will be repeated many times and I would certainly consider scheduling "Pedal America" in conjunction with repeats of the national park series. "
